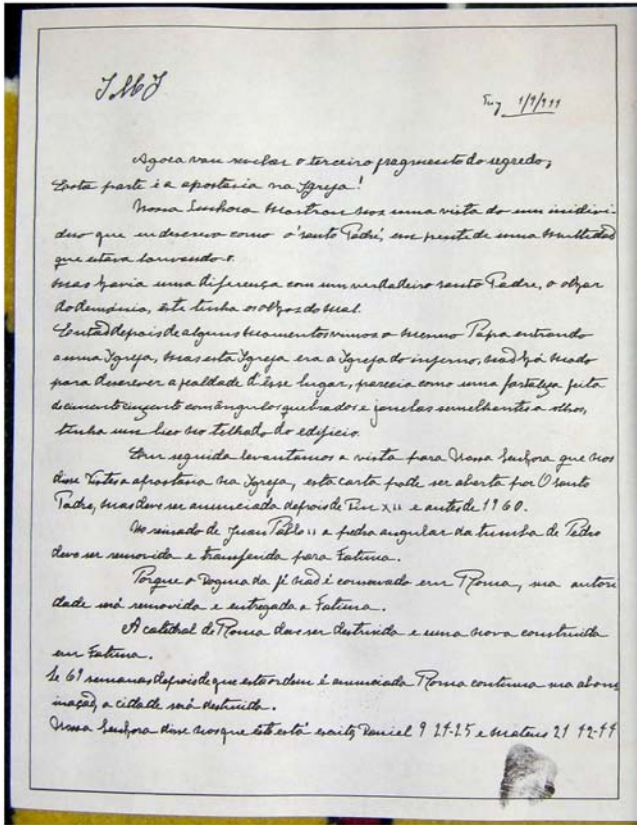


The Authentic Third Secret of Fatima

version, as, for instance, in the substitution of "The Lord" for "Our Lord" and finally the printing of the verses separately. The first edition of the New Testament appeared in 1749, the second, together with the first edition of the Old Testament, in 1750. Between these two editions there are but few differences, but the third edition, published in 1752, had important changes both in text and notes, the variations numbering over two thousand. Dr. Challoner's Bible has been the groundwork of nearly all subsequent English versions. An American edition was published in Philadelphia in 1805.

JESUS CHRIST, the Messiah. See CHRIST. JE/SUS, or JOS'UE, son of Josedeck, high-priest of the Jews after the Babylonian captivity; regulated the order and offices of the priests and Levites (1 Esd. iii. 3, 8); the prophet Aggeus urged him to hasten the rebuilding of the temple (Agg. i. 2); foretelling that the desired of nations should come (Zach. iii. 1-9); saw him in spirit crowned with a tiara, and also in iv. 2; vi. 11; associated with promises of the coming of the Orient or Messias. The son of Sirach praises him (Eccles. xlix. 14).
